#### **Repertoire:** Concerto for Multiple Soloists (2–4 Performers)

This category will allow for concerti such as the Bach Concerto for Two Violins, Concerto for Violin and Oboe, Vivaldi Concerto for Four Violins, Brahms Concerto for Violin and Cello, etc. Non-concerti pieces are not allowed (the word "Concerto" or similar must be in the title). Maximum of up to four (4) soloists. Age Division is determined by the oldest member of the soloists. Piano is accompaniment only and is not to be a student entry.
